OFFICER

1 THE WITNESS: Yes. The shoe size. I spoke with
2 Mrs. Gabbour regarding that. And she held one of her
3 (Karen's) other shoes to it, and it was the exact size.

4 A JUROR: How about the hair? As far as the hair, I
5 know the hair could be tinted and that stuff. The color of
6 the hair, blonde? Brunette?

7 THE WITNESS: Yes.

8 Q: Is there a description referring to the missing person's
9 report in the description?

10 A: Brown hair, brown eyes, thin build, 120 pounds, 5'2". I
11 had been with Karen Marsden a few days prior to her
12 disappearance in questioning her. The hair found at the
13 scene seemed the exact same color as Karen Marsden's hair.

14 Q: That hair has also been sent to Washington, D.C. for an
15 analysis.

16 A: Yes.

17 Q: Did you obtain any comparison hair from the grandmother?

18 A: Yes, we did.

19 Q: How did you get that hair?

20 A: We went down to Mrs. Gabbour's home and in the bedroom,
21 Karen Marsden's bedroom, we found several coats that were
22 hanging in the closet, wool type coats, and we found two
23 or three pieces of hair, strands of hair, inside the
24 coat. We were able to remove those strands. The coat was
